When recognized, please begin by providing your name and address for the record (optional). Anyone wishing to submit written information at the meeting needs to furnish ten (10) copies to the City Clerk in advance to allow for distribution to City Council, staff, and the media. Willful disruption of the meeting shall not be permitted. If the Mayor finds that there is in fact willful disruption of any City Council Meeting, he/she may order the disrupting parties out of the room and subsequently conduct the City’s business without them present.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF  
MCFARLAND AMENDING MCFARLAND MUNICIPAL  
CODE CHAPTER 2.40 TO ADD SECTION 2.40.100.**

**Section 1. Recitals.**

**WHEREAS**, The City of McFarland (“City”) desires to codify its Municipal Code Chapter related to Planning Commission compensation;

**WHEREAS**, This Ordinance updates the McFarland Municipal Code to promulgate the compensation planning commissioners for the City of McFarland are entitled to receive;

**WHEREAS**, Adoption of this Ordinance is in furtherance of the City’s goals and objectives and reduces the potentially negative impacts incompatible Municipal Code Chapters and Sections could cause.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCFARLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 2.** Chapter 2.40 of the McFarland Municipal Code is hereby amended and adopted to add Section 2.40.100, to read as follows:

**2.40.100- Compensation.**

- A. The compensation of the Planning Commission Chairman/Chairwoman and four commissioners is fixed at fifty (50) dollars per month, commencing on the first day of the month following the effective date of this Section.
  
- B. The Planning Commission’s Chairman/Chairwoman and Commissioners shall be reimbursed for all sums necessarily incurred or paid by him/her in the performance of his/her duties; reimbursement shall only be made, however, when a verified, itemized claim, setting forth the sums expended for such business for which reimbursement is requested, has been presented to the City Council and thereafter approved.

**Section 3.** The Amended Chapter 2.40 of the McFarland Municipal Code is set forth in Exhibit “A” to this Ordinance and incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 4. NOTICE.** The City clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be posted within 15 days after its passage, in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code.

**Section 5. Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is, for any reason, deemed or held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, or preempted by legislative enactment, such decision or legislation shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. #### **SUMMARY:**

Best Friends Animal Society has reached out to multiple city shelters and rescues to see if they would like to participate in their campaign of the ability to adopt and foster at least 1,000 Big Dogs weighing 40 or more pounds. There are 20 cities and rescues participating in this campaign. This campaign was created by the Best Friends Animal Society which has donated annually to our Animal Shelter.

The campaign consists of an adoption fee to be waived or reduced to a minimal fee of \$22. The total amount of \$22 to represents the year 2022 in this campaign. The staff would like Council to give direction if the city should participate and reduce/waive adoption fees for large dogs over 40 pounds. The current shelter residents are 75% large dogs and would help find these dogs a home. This campaign will only be from January 15<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> 2022.

Participating will give the shelter the benefits below:

- Multiple opportunities for grant funding – just for participating!
- Best Friends Animal Society will be launching a microsite and massive marketing/public relations campaign to drive adopters and fosters to participating agencies.
- Helpful marketing toolkit with downloadable materials for promotion on your own agency site/outlets.

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**BACKGROUND:**

By way of background, Councilmember Santillano was appointed into office on August 5, 2021, by application method to fill vacant seat that was left by prior Councilmember Eric Rodriguez who also resigned his office as a member of the City Council on June 9, 2021. Thereafter, following the requirements of Government Code section 36512, the Council appointed Vidal Santillano. Less than two months after appointment, on or about September 29, 2021, Mr. Santillano gave a verbal resignation to then Interim City Manager/Chief of Police Kenny Williams and he turned in all City of McFarland property in his possession. The City Manager requested Mr. Santillano provide a formal letter of resignation, to properly document his decision. Although Mr. Santillano informed the City Manager that he would provide a letter of resignation, no letter was received. As such, City Clerk Alvarado contacted Mr. Santillano and again requested a formal letter of resignation. Mr. Santillano again stated he would provide such a letter to City Manager Williams but has yet to. Alvarado called multiple times after and has not been able to contact Mr. Santillano again.

Government Code Section 36513 states “(a) If a city councilmember is absent without permission from all regular city council meetings for 60 days consecutively from the last regular meeting he or she attended, his or her office becomes vacant and shall be filled as any other vacancy.”

Mr. Santillano has been absent from all Regular and Special City Council Meetings since September 30, 2021 and his absences were without permission.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the City Council approve the resolution to remove Vidal Santillano from council seat pursuant to Government Code section 36513.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-0001**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCFARLAND REMOVING COUNCILMEMBER VIDAL SANTILLANO FROM CITY COUNCIL PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 36513**

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Rodriguez resigned his office as a member of the Council effective June 9, 2021.

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Rodriguez was elected to office in 2021, and had less than 1 year remaining in his term of office as a Councilmember. That resignation created a vacancy on the City Council that needed to be filled by the new City Council either by appointment or by calling a special election.

**WHEREAS**, the person appointed or elected would fill the vacant seat for the remainder of the term of that seat, and that seat would then be up for election in November 2022.

**WHEREAS**, the City of McFarland had not enacted an ordinance as contemplated by Government Code Section 36512(c), which states that a city may enact an ordinance that requires that a special election be called immediately or provides that a person appointed to the vacant seat only hold the office until the date of the special election; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code Section 36512(b), if a vacancy occurs in an elective office, the Council shall, within 60 days from the commencement of the vacancy, either fill the vacancy by appointment or call a special election to fill the vacancy; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code Section 36512, at the special meeting of June 17, 2021, the newly seated City Council unanimously chose the appointment process to fill that vacancy; and

**WHEREAS**, at that meeting, the Council also directed those interested in being appointed to file applications with the City Clerk on or before July 21, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council reviewed all applications submitted, and, at its August 12, 2021 meeting, the public and each applicant were provided an opportunity to address the Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council duly considered input received at the meeting; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council selected Vidal Santillano to fill the Council term vacated by Councilmember Rodriguez; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 36513 states “(a) If a city councilmember is absent without permission from all regular city council meetings for 60 days consecutively from the last regular meeting he or she attended, his or her office becomes vacant and shall be filled as any other vacancy.

**WHEREAS**, Council Member Santillano has been absent from all Regular and Special City Council Meetings since September, 2021, and such absences were without permission.

**WHEREAS**, all other legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution and appointment have occurred.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of McFarland resolves as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

**SECTION 2.** Pursuant to Government Code Section 36513, Vidal Santillano is hereby removed from the office of Council Member that was vacated by the resignation of former incumbent Councilmember Rodriguez.

**SECTION 3.** The City Clerk shall notify the Kern County Registrar of Voters of the City Council's action.

**SECTION 4.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution.

**SECTION 5.** This resolution is effective immediately.

**SUBJECT:** CITY COUNCIL DISCUSSION OF OPTIONS REGARDING THE PROCESS FOR FILLING THE VACANCY ON THE CITY COUNCIL AND DIRECTION TO STAFF REGARDING THE SAME

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the City Council discuss initial options regarding how to fill the vacancy on the City Council and provide direction to Staff regarding the same.

**BACKGROUND:**

Under State law the City Council is required to fill a vacancy on the City Council either by appointing another Councilmember or holding a special election. There are various options for appointment. Staff is requesting direction from the Council as to how to proceed.

**Options for Filling Vacancies**

Government Code Section 36512 establishes the means by which a City Council vacancy may be filled. The City does not have an ordinance requiring a certain method for filling a vacancy. Consequently, under Section 36512(b), the City Council has the discretion to either (i) fill the vacancy by appointment or (ii) call for a special election.

The City Council must make this decision – to either fill the vacancy by appointment or call for a special election – within 60 days after the vacancy is created.

***Filling Vacancy by Appointment***

If the City Council chooses to fill the vacancy by appointment, the specific method of appointment is within in the Council’s discretion, so long as the appointment is made within the 60-day time period. To be eligible, any person appointed must meet the minimum legal requirements required to run for office. For the City of McFarland, these are:

- The candidate must be a registered voter of the City (including age requirements).
- The candidate must maintain a legal residence or domicile within the City.

- The willingness to be appointed.

In addition to the minimum qualifications, the City Council can consider a wide variety of other factors that may affect a potential appointee's suitability to serve in office, including experience, background, etc.

When filling a vacancy by appointment, there are three common approaches that are used by many public agencies: (i) applications by interested persons; ii) the candidate with the next highest number of votes (next-highest vote getter); or iii) outright appointment (no application).

**(i) Application Method.**

Under the "application" option, the City Council would establish an application period for appointee hopefuls to submit an official City application with the City Clerk, with the intention of making an appointment at a future Council meeting after consideration of the applications.

If Council wishes to fill the vacancy under this method, Staff request the Council provide direction such as:

- Notice: How notice is to be provided (publication in paper, posting, word of mouth, etc.).
- Application content: Would the Council like to make any changes to the application?
- Deadline for Submittals: When the applications should be submitted to the City Clerk?
- Deadline for Distribution: When the applications should be provided to the Council (either prior to or concurrent with the Agenda for the meeting)?

Note: If the City Council opts to fill the vacancy by appointment, the Brown Act requires any interviews conducted by the entire City Council to be held in open session.

**(ii) Next-Highest-Vote-Getter Method.**

Under this option, the City Council would appoint the candidate who received the highest number of votes in the election among the candidates who were not elected.

**(iii) Outright Appointment (No Application) Method.**

Under this option, the Council may make an appointment without going through an application process. The appointee is legally required to meet the age, residency, and voter registration requirements, and must be willing to be appointed. If the Council is inclined to pursue this option, it can direct staff to place an item on the agenda for appointment at a future meeting.

**(iv) Other.**

The City Council could also select another method of appointment, different from those discussed above.

### ***Filling Vacancy by Special Election***

Alternatively, the City Council may call a special election to fill the vacancy. The special election shall be held on the next regularly established election date not less than 114 days calculated after the call of the special election. In other words, the special election must be at least 115 days or more after the date of the determination to hold the election. The exact cost of holding a special election is not known at this time. However, they typically start out \$15,000 or more depending on the number of voters and other factors (a recent Bakersfield special election to fill a ward seat cost over \$100,000).

Due to the cost of holding a special election, most cities fill vacancies by appointment.

City staff also recommend using the appointment method in order to avoid such costs.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is a minimal fiscal impact associated with appointment other than certain Staff time, etc. If directed, Staff can attempt to obtain a more detailed estimate from the County as to the cost of holding a special election.

**2.04.010 – Time set for meetings.**

**2.04.020 – Meeting place designated.**

The Veterans Hall/City Council Chambers at 103 W Sherwood Ave, McFarland CA 93250, is established as the meeting place for the city council.
